Representative Team Tryouts

Applications for representative team tryouts must be made NOW!

Number of teams and age groups represented will depend on the level of interest in each age group. Last year we had 1x 15&Under, 2x 13&Under and 1x 11&Under team.

Proposed changes for this years representative teams include:

- More regular training, on alternating Saturdays, after normal games.
- Election of a team captain.
- Updated set of policies governing the running of the representative teams.
- \$20 upfront subscription to be a member of the rep-team to cover the cost of training.
- Tournament costs will be \$20 per tournament per player.
- Each player must purchase a PVNA rep-top \$20 top, (A \$35 rep-jacket is optional)

Tryouts will be on 24th February 2007 @ 12:00-2pm. Player applications should be submitted by Sat. 17th February.

Umpires&Rules

Short pass, rule 13.5.1. The Rule states: On the court: at the moment the ball is passed there must be room for a third player to move between the hands of the thrower and those of the receiver.



At the Throwin: at the moment the ball is passed there must be room **on the court** for a third player to move between the hands of the thrower and the receiver.

It should be remembered in both incidences the distance is judged at the moment the ball is passed, not where the players are when the ball is received, which is, in most incidences completely different than where they were when the ball was passed.

Think about it!!

Teams information - RECAP

*A player may play as an emergency in **one** Senior Side only, but once they have played 3 games in that team they cannot go back to the Junior Side.*

Clarification

*13 and under players are permitted to play 2 games only with one 15 and under team as an emergency
11 and under players are permitted to play 2 games only with one 13 and under team as an emergency*

If any teams require players to make a game (do not have 5 players) and players from SAME section are asked to play and do so, it is FUN and considered a scratch match.

*Both teams pay the game fee, and the team who had sufficient players & agreed to the scratch match score 4 points and 10 goals (rule pertaining to a walkover).
If the team who has sufficient players decide not to play a scratch match will be awarded 4 points & other team MUST pay a walkover fee of \$70.*
