## Umpires&Rules

**S**ome of the players are unsure of the Rule using the Pole:

Players are not permitted to use the goalpost either to regain balance, or as a support in recovering the ball from going out of court, or in any way, or for any other purpose which does not include the ball rebounding from the goalpost.

Neither the goalers or defenders are permitted to use the pole.

If the goal post is used in any of the methods mentioned above free pass is awarded to the non offending team.

If the defender causes the goal post to move in an attempt at goal, a penalty Shot or Pass is awarded.

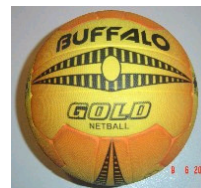
The team members have not only achieved great success in finals as a team but have also achieved personal milestones in the number of games played with Plenty Valley:
