Rules

Untouched Centre Pass;

The Centre pass must be caught or touched in the Centre Third by a player with both feet in the centre third. The player is permitted to land on one foot and then step on from the centre third to the goal third.

If a player catches the ball with one foot in the goal third and one in the centre third, an infringement has occurred, and a free pass is awarded to the opposing team.

Something for consideration:

The Rules protect the player who is playing the ball but not the player who is playing the body.

Score Sheets

We hope that the score sheets have made things a bit easier for team managers. They currently enable us to gather the results of each game and the list of players who have played during that game.

Currently the list of player names is based on registered players, and those that have played the week before. If a TICK is placed in the "Plyd" (played) column for a player then the player has played. NO TICK means they did not play and may not qualify (3 games minimum) for the finals and will not appear the following weeks score sheet.

You can place player positions (eg. GS) on the score sheet if you like, and the score sheet will retain this information for you.

Player names are important, umpires use these to enable the Best&Fairest votes to be given.

Any injury that occurs during a game should be noted on the back of the score sheet.

A scorer from each team should be sitting together during the game, overseeing scoring.

Your score sheet will also let you know when one of your players has a birthday coming up or had recently, watch out for it!!
