NewRule Book

The New Rule book has arrived and can be purchased at the desk for \$15.

Rules

Obstruction of a player not in possession of ball.



A player is obstructing if within a distance of 0.9 metre measured on the ground from an opponent without the ball, **any movements** are employed by that player whether attacking or defending which take the arms away from the body, other than those involved in natural body balance.

Any movements, players are permitted to outstretch arms to catch or deflect or intercept or feint a pass, but you cannot leave an arm outstretched.

Think about it, the arm can go out and return to your body then if the ball has not been released outstretch again. This is often seen at the throw in or around the circle or at the centre pass.

Think about it, does this play come into your game, and how is it dealt within the rules.
