Boys @PVNA

The BYLAW governing boys playing in our Saturday morning competition has slightly changed. As an association we have quite a generous BYLAW, compared to other associations around Victoria.

We allow boys to play in ALL our age groups from 11&U through to 17&U with some restrictions. In the 11&U you can have up to 7 boys. The 13&U and 15&U age groups can only have 3 boys on the court (but they must be in separate zones, for example you can not have two boys defending GD and GK). The 17&U age group can have 1 boy on the court at any one time. They must comply with the same age restrictions as the girls, which is based on their age on the 31st Dec.

Vandalism

We had a problem last Saturday with vandalism in the ladies toilets. The vandalism took the form of taking toilet paper from the dispensers, tearing up and spreading around the room and in the showers.

BNASC Entry

We are currently offering the option to purchase bulk entry passes to the Bundoora Netball and Sports Centre to cater for recent demand. Currently the pricing structure is:

- \$2.00 for an adult
